### Summary of student's answers:

On an average, the students were satisfied with the course and the teaching.

### Teachers' comments:

Traditional lectures were given, exercise classes, computer laboratory exercises and a group project. The lectures followed closely a newly written preliminary textbook by the lecturer. Most of the exercises in the book provide full solutions.

Unfortunately, the participation rate was low at the lectures and the exercise sessions. Many students failed the first exam.

### Changes from the previous course realisation:

The novelty this year was that a new course book was used.

Since most of the students were satisfied with the course, no major changes will be made next year.


# Summary of questionnaires






Distribution of the answers from question 17: education"




# Summary scales divided on satisfaction


