
Since less than 20 students have answared the questionnaire no statistical significance tests have been made.



Distribution of the answers from question 17: education"







there was barely any teacher-student interaction during zoom lectures. we kept it to the minimum. the teacher was not very supportive with students' learning. he didn't allow us to record the lectures, nor did he make the lecture notes available even though it was pandemic time and this could be very helpful for students to learn. Moreover, we had to use respondus, a facial recognition software so we could be monitored during the exam. Given the fact that the teacher never wanted to be recorded, he didn't seem to have any problem with us being recorded. Nor did he care that maybe we also don't want to be recorded. Does this practice even in accordance with GDPR?

In my experience with other course, the teachers usually just make the exams more challenging and give us more time to work on the exams on our own. Nobody needs to be recorded and uploaded online. I didn't feel stressed about doing things that might make the software think I was cheating and could focus better on the exam.
