Evaluation

It was the second time we arranged teaching via Zoom, p.g.a. Coronavirus. Overall this seems to have gone relatively well judging by the course evaluation. The book receives multiple good grades, the seminars receive very good grades if the teaching is divided and is evenly distributed between good and bad. During the spring the courses were held by me going through prewritten pdf-lecture notes, with occasional breaks for using an iPad to explain some detail or exercise. This was not optimal, so in this course I had ordinary lectures which I streamed via zoom. In summary, it is unclear which teaching form was most appreciated by the students. One thing that needs improvement, regardless, is the quality of the camera while lecturing over zoom. This is now available through the department.

Make exams that you are able to prepare for by doing the old exams and with material that are similar to them. Make the exams more clearly. Always grad ALL exams fully and don't be lazy when doing so.

The seminars worked poorly when they were essentially non-interactive. It was hard to follow on problems I had gotten stuck on.

The lecturer lacked organisation in the lectures and they were very hard to follow. He also mainly used a handwritten pdf file to point at during most of the lectures and that made it almost impossible to follow and to take notes on the lectures. He also refused to answer questions via messages in canvas and just ignored the messages and did not even bother to ask the students to ask the questions at the lectures because he did not find it important enough. And sometimes when a question was asked in the lectures he could not answer it because he did not bring the book to the lecture and asked if one could ask the seminar teacher instead. In every other course one has been able to ask questions via messages in canvas outside of the lectures so I do not see why it is so hard now.

The structure and the way of teaching

Information about exams came too late. The lectures where messy, unstructured, and unengaged. The information given in the lectures was not useable at all studying for the exam. It didn't feel like the lecturer wanted to hold the course at all!

Very bad, gave information not really used. My notes were useless





The teacher during the seminars did a great job and was vital for my understanding of the course and was the only one I felt comfortable asking questions to.



The assingment had its presentation after the course exam and collided with the new courses that started the week after the exam. This should maybe be looked into in the future.



Whereas the rather unorthodox substitution for question 1 hindered my confidence going forward, I still found that the question itself was fair, and in hindsight, I should have been able to navigate the question using my prior knowledge. However, I found that the exam was heavily biased towards optimisation, leaving concepts that I had personally dedicated quite a bit of time towards understanding such as PDEs completely off the exam. While the exam was relatively easy, and my grade is due primarily to my own shortcomings and not exclusively due to the given exam, I still feel that the exam did a poor job of properly representing the material of the course.

Make exams that are somewhat like the old once

It's frustrating when there are questions that entirely hinge on knowing the specifics of a term that was mentioned in a lecture but which I don't recall any exercises on. It feel like I'm being tested on minutia instead of the meat of the course.

The exam was, in my opinion, unpredictable and unnecessarily tricky. While fairly covering the course subjects a lot of questions where clad in ambiguity making them harder than they needed to be. Even compared to the wide range of past exams this one was particularly tricky.

The way the examination was taken should be improved if it is done from home again because it was 5 hours straight where we were survailanced over zoom which made it a bit more difficult to go to the bathroom and it could have made it more possible for people to cheat and people who did not cheat to feel uncertain of going to the bathroom and risking suspicion.

Receiving responses on questions during the exam was occasionally very slow. There should be several people supervising these online exams and not just one.
