

#### Course Analysis for MATB25 Discrete Mathematics, Autumn 2021

#### Course Information

Number of students:

34 newly registered and 8 re-registered.

6 students answered the course evaluation, 2 of them are enrolled on programme name, and 1 was

on the teacher education programme.

#### Examination

Project: 27 students passed.

**Oral examination:** 25 students passed.

**Written examination**: 34 students passed (9 of which were teacher students).

- Ordinary examination 17/12 2021: 33 students participated and 28 of them passed.
- Resit examination 12/01 2022: 8 students participated and 6 of them passed.

#### Final grades:

In all, 34 students, including 6 re-registered students, have got their final grade.

16 passed with distinction.

18 passed (9 of which were teacher students).

This course was given jointly for science students, teacher students and engineering students with respective course codes MATB25, ÄMAD04 and FMAB75 (though this survey was only sent to MATB25 and ÄMAD04 students, as FMAB75 students received a separate CEQ survey). The lectures and seminars were held on campus. The lecture notes were uploaded on Canvas. For each seminar, a given list of exercises were to be discussed. The participation in the lectures and seminars were good. The examination was carried out on campus.

#### Changes from the previous course realisation:

The previous course was held completely via Zoom, whereas this course was held as normal in a lecture hall, and seminar rooms. No changes were made to the course content.


**Suggestions for the next course realisation**: The syllabus could be shortened a little, to avoid having to sometimes rush through the material during the lectures.


